My name is Bruce Enemark, the youngest son of Jim & Mardy, whom you have been supporting for years. As I saw your names on their financial statement, I thought it would be good to let you know how they are doing.

My mother suffered a rather severe stroke last year on July 3, taking the use of her left extremities. She has been in a rehab facility here in Sanford, Florida. It did affect her memory and somewhat her emotions and logic.

Dad has been in the apartment in the assisted living facility of NTM Homes. We have seen him deteriorate slowly as his walking is getting more labored, has good long-term memory, but his short-term memory is not good. He is 89.

I have been his main caregiver, taken over his banking for him and driving him to visit Mom.

My wife, Julie, and I are presently here in Sanford, working in the home office. We were 16 years in Panama and then another 8 years in Paraguay before coming here. Julie is administrative aid to the director of the information and technology department. I am the managing editor of Ethnos 360/NTM publications.

I want to express my thanks to you for your continued financial and prayer support for both of them. Thank you again for all you do for Jim & Mardy. God bless you richly.


