I am serving as Seed Company Field Coordinator to Francophone Africa DRC/CAR as a missionary under Wycliffe Bible Translators.



My job feels like the talent show of the “Spinning Plates”. You remember an array of poles with a ceramic plate spinning on top of each one. The person runs from pole to pole to keep the poles spinning and the plates from falling. Some plates do fall.

My job is a lot like that. Three New Testament projects running in Central Africa Republic (CAR). Three more in Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). Eight languages in a Trauma Healing project in CAR. Twelve more in an oral Bible storytelling project in DRC. Twenty-four more waiting for Trauma Healing training in CAR. Jesus film team coming to record nine languages in DRC. And on it goes.

God’s Word gives hope and it is worth sharing. I thank each of you that prays for and supports the life-giving projects of Bible translation. I have been blessed and encouraged by your commitment to my role in this endeavor.
