The Missionary Training Center (MTC) grants me extra time off each summer. I guess it's because I'm 85 and they aren't sure how to handle me. They are very gracious and because of that, I get to spend extra time with my family, especially my grandkids.

I am now back at MTC. Our classes began August 12. We have 48 new students; the previous class had 37, plus 7 linguistic students. It is good to be back into the swing of things, to have a routine. My day begins at 4:30 or 5am and some days I meet with

a students as early as 6am.

I have been specifically assigned 2 or 3 more single men in August for mentoring and I usually have others that want to meet with me during the week.

These days I am able to be in contact with my former students that I've mentored on 'WhatsApp'. Their voices and pictures are as clear as a bell and it doesn't cost anything. We talk about their language and culture study, how they are building relationships with different people, how they get out to visit people in their homes and are only speaking in the language they are learning.

Some are in Indonesia, others in Zanzibar and one in Burma. Eight of them are now half way through learning the national language and have another 12 months. Then they will be assigned to an unreached people group to learn that language. This is a long process, but it pays off in the long run.

Thank you so much for your continued support and prayers.

**Radio Broadcast** — If you can't attend on a Sunday morning, tune in to 91.9FM, The Bridge, at 10:30am to listen to the service.

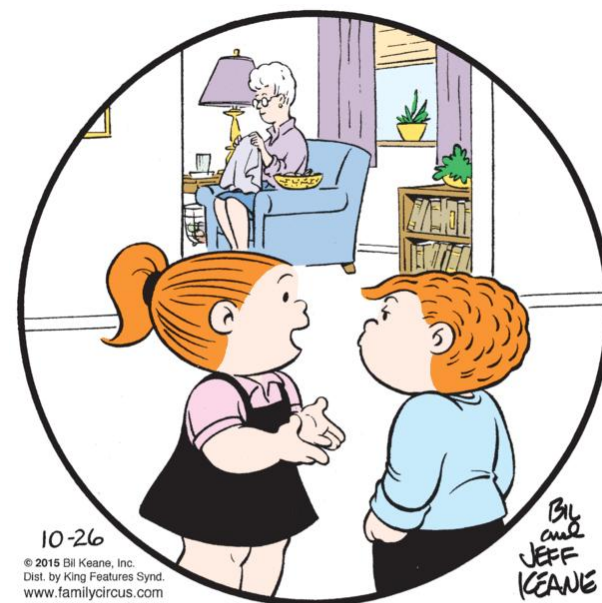
