### What will Phase 3 gatherings look like?

\*We will move into Phase 3 when when Minnesota, including Koochiching County, has a sustained reduction in new cases of COVID-19 for 14 days

**During these limited gatherings, we will take every precaution according to guidance from the health department:**

*We will have a 9am and a 11am service. (This will allow us an hour to disinfect the sanctuary)*

*We will limit services to 80 people.*

*To provide for safe distance, families and individuals will sit staggered to one side of a pew, the other side on the next pew, and so on.*

*Sunday School and nursery will not meet.*

*Unless on-stage, all volunteers and staff will wear masks.*

*All attendees are encouraged to wear masks. The church will have masks available for those needing one.*

*We will not serve coffee or food.*

*We will not pass offering baskets. In place there will be an offering box that people can use on the way in or out.*

*Please do not come to your service earlier than 15 minutes; Please exit the building after your service is done.*

*Anyone experiencing fever, cough, or other COVID-19 symptoms should not attend.*

*Vulnerable populations should not attend but should worship in the service online, TV, or radio.*
