I would like to bring you up to date with ministry and life changes. This summer was packed with ministry.

For the month of May I had the responsibility of running the Monticello Timber Bay area and maintaining a presence in the local schools. One evening the leaders and I had a great discussion with our high schoolers on the sanctity of life. I valued hearing the kids' outspokenness on the changes they wanted to see.

In June, we found ourselves on our annual white water rafting trip on the Wolf River in Wisconsin. The kids really enjoyed the challenge of navigating the rapids.

In July, my three 10th grade girls and I went to camp to volunteer in the kitchen. Every bed was full at camp that week so we had an adventure tent camping in the woods. This was a great way to challenge the girls to face their fears together and get them out of their comfort zone. This was 5 whole days of challenging growth.

In August, the week-long Work Crew was also a hit! For five days our projects included cutting down trees and teaching our high school boys how to use power tools while building a lean-to for the barn.

All these events are to reach young people for Christ, to have them question why they are here, to see there is a better way to live and know God loves them.
