Seeking candidates for summer internship! Do you know someone who might be looking for a way to participate in ministry internationally? Our team in Senegal hosted four interns this past summer who all reported having had good experiences here

as they got an inside look at missionary life.

In the course of six weeks, they were exposed to a range of local ministry options: got a taste of Senegalese culture and history, received some training in discipleship ministry and even learned a little of the Wolof language.

We would also like to invite you to participate with us in starting 2024 in prayer for us and our Metro SanWest Initiative team. Actually, it is not so much for us and our team, but for the world we are engaged in. As a team we are asking God for 5% of the people in what we refer to as Senegal's 'urbantriangle' to become reproducing disciples of Jesus. For now we are walking in faith, taking steps that equip us for ministry with our Converge colleagues. To that end, learning French is a priority.
