When will it rain? The whole country is in a drought. Since early November of last year and continuing until March according to the weather forecast. We are living in extremely dry conditions with intense heat. It is predicted that February will be even hotter.



Many areas in the country are burning with the fires out of control. I depend on the mountain to supply water for the house, but I do purchase drinking water as the water that comes down from the mountain is not potable. Many of the crops have been lost and the animals are dying as the drought extends.

When I preached at the Shalom Community Christian Church, they had invited those who had aged out of the Peace House for Boys which is a home for boys at risk. The church has an ongoing relationship with those who have graduated from their childhood years in the Peace House and are currently in high school, college, technical schools or working among other things. I thank God for the adults at Shalom Church who follow-up with them in meetings and periodically to accompany them as needed in their teenage years and beyond.

Prayer Requests:

- 1. For the government to respond efficiently in the areas where the fires are burning and where the conditions are worsening from the drought.
- 2. That the water will continue to flow from the mountain.
- 3. For the annual meeting of the Covenant Church in Columbia in March.
