Anna: At the end of October I was asked if I would accompany a team of high school juniors and seniors on a short-term trip to the islands of Boracay and Panay in the Philippines. Although I could think of so many things to stop me from going, God kept saying to me, "serve with humility."



In surrender, I emailed the leader that I would volunteer and help in any way. I found out that they wanted me, as a nurse, to coordinate health-screening at two Filipino schools that have a student population of 500 students from kindergarten to high school. "One nurse and a few high school students to do 500 health check-ups in 4 days. Impossible!' All the teachers and high school students had a part to do such as crafts, teaching stories, construction, sports, skits and games. My part was to get ready for the health checks and coordinate with 8-10 students to help me.

Their expensive Nike shoes got dirty and their clothes stank after working such long days. When it came to do the health checks, those students involved gladly helped and we were like a fine-tuned assembly line with several stations, each doing their part of the health exams. With God's help we did as much as we could, and I handed over a huge pile of health exams to those in charge.

For someone who has been a long-term missionary for 20 years, I was surprised to see how God used these students to bless so many and I could see my own attitude change and soften after being with them for one week. It also blessed me to use my professional skills to care for so many students.
