The last few months have shown me how desperately I need to depend on He who loves me. It has been tough in I Falls lately, but our awesome God continues to be good. With the passing of Christian Hufnagle we saw tremendous pain in the youth group, young adult group, in me and Rachel personally, and in our community as a whole. Despite this, after meeting with many people to process this death, we have seen God's wonderful care. Instead of hiding from the pain with drugs, alcohol, or isolation – we have seen both youth and young adults grow in their walks with God, go to Him in their hurt, connect with the body of Christ, and ultimately rest in Him. This isn't to say that the pain isn't still there or that no one has struggled, but it reveals that the promises of God remain true. That like a loving Father, He will embrace us in our questions and in our pain. He continually shows His goodness to us.

Matthew 11:28-30 – "Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and YOU WILL FIND REST FOR YOUR SOULS. "For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

What a rollercoaster of emotions! Still, contemplating my mortality has been a blessing. I long to cling more aggressively to my Savior than finances, fame, talent, or even my life. Still, we'd appreciate prayer as there is potential of a surgery with a 6 week recovery time, which would be especially difficult considering our current family situation.

Which brings us to our most recent news! On May 15, Rachel and I welcomed two foster sisters into our home. We're now outnumbered with four kids who are all under four years old! It has been amazing, exhausting, humbling, and once again a reminder that we desperately need God! Without God's grace and the support of our church (and biological) family through meals, prayer, and meeting other random needs, we truly would not be able to take this on. Thank you so much for loving and caring for Rachel and I throughout all of the things happening in our lives personally and in ministry. Please continually be praying for us!
